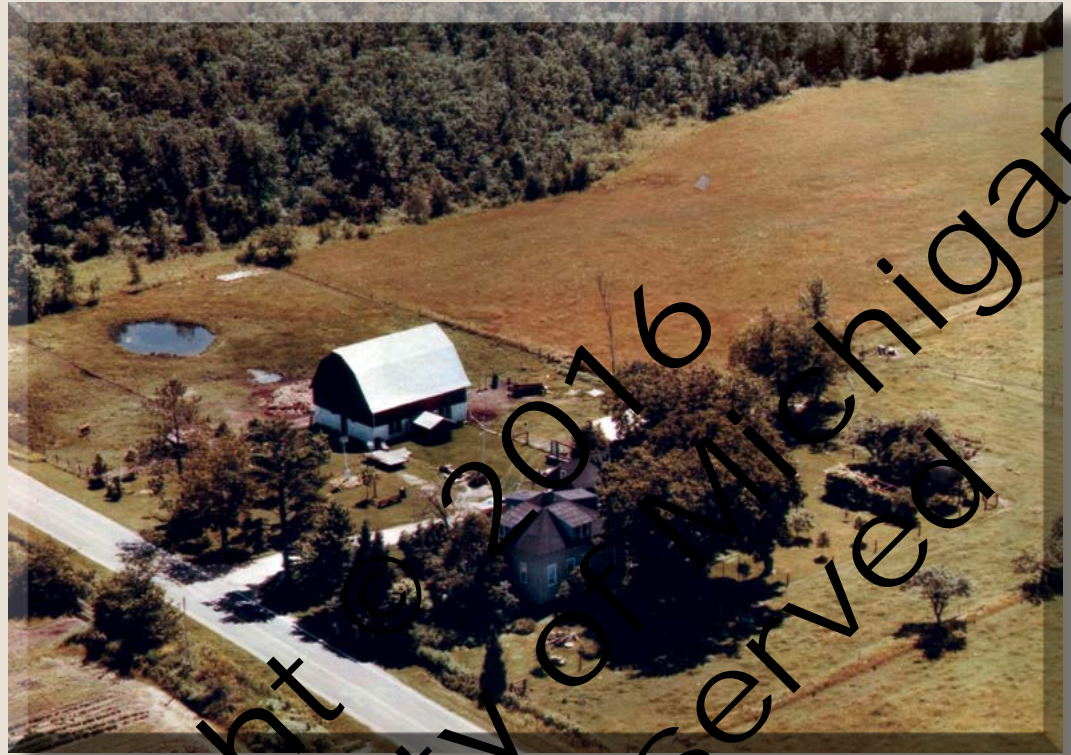


sons, Gerald and Ted, built the rest of the structures that exist on the property today. A new barn was constructed by 1949, and the smaller outbuildings were constructed from 1965 to 2010. The new barn was used for beef cattle for 25 years, until a hand injury caused Gerald to stop raising them. Gerald and his wife, Florence, were married in 1960, and they purchased the land from Cyrille in 1969. Gerald and Florence's children, Cheryl and Tim, also own parcels of the original land. Gerald and Florence continue to farm garlic, potatoes, beans, carrots, and raspberries today.
