The Historical Society of Michigan presents the **Charles Follo Award** to an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to the preservation and promotion of the history of the Upper Peninsula.

The award was established in 1979 to honor the memory of Charles Follo, a school teacher from Escanaba who was an ardent supporter and contributor to the work of historical societies in the Upper Peninsula.

The Historical Society of Michigan presents the **Superior Award** to a historical organization that has made an outstanding contribution to the preservation and promotion of the history of the Upper Peninsula. The award was established in 2006 to honor historical societies, museums, and other historical organizations in the Upper Peninsula for their efforts to advance Upper Peninsula history.

Both awards will be presented at the Historical Society of Michigan's Upper Peninsula History Conference.
